**Brief Job Description:** The Maine Department of Environmental Protection is seeking candidates for an Assistant Environmental Engineer with the Division of Water Quality Management. This entry-level position consists of managing projects for the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) that primarily provides low interest loans to municipal and quasi-municipal wastewater treatment facilities. The specific duties include working with consulting engineers, municipal officials, contractors, the public and other state and federal agencies in developing facility plans, reviewing applications, engineering plans and specifications, operation and maintenance manuals, onsite construction activities, review and approval of project payment requisitions and documentation for federal record keeping requirements. The position also consists of managing projects for the overboard discharge (OBD) grant removal program to ensure OBDs are removed in a timely manner. These duties include the review of program eligibility, site evaluation designs (in accordance with the Maine Subsurface Disposal Rules), onsite construction activities and project payment requisitions.

**Minimum Qualifications:** A Bachelors Degree in Environmental, Civil, Sanitary, Mechanical, or Chemical Engineering, or related Engineering field. Related experience may be substituted for education. **Preference** will be given to candidates with experience utilizing the Maine Subsurface Wastewater Disposal Rules.
